

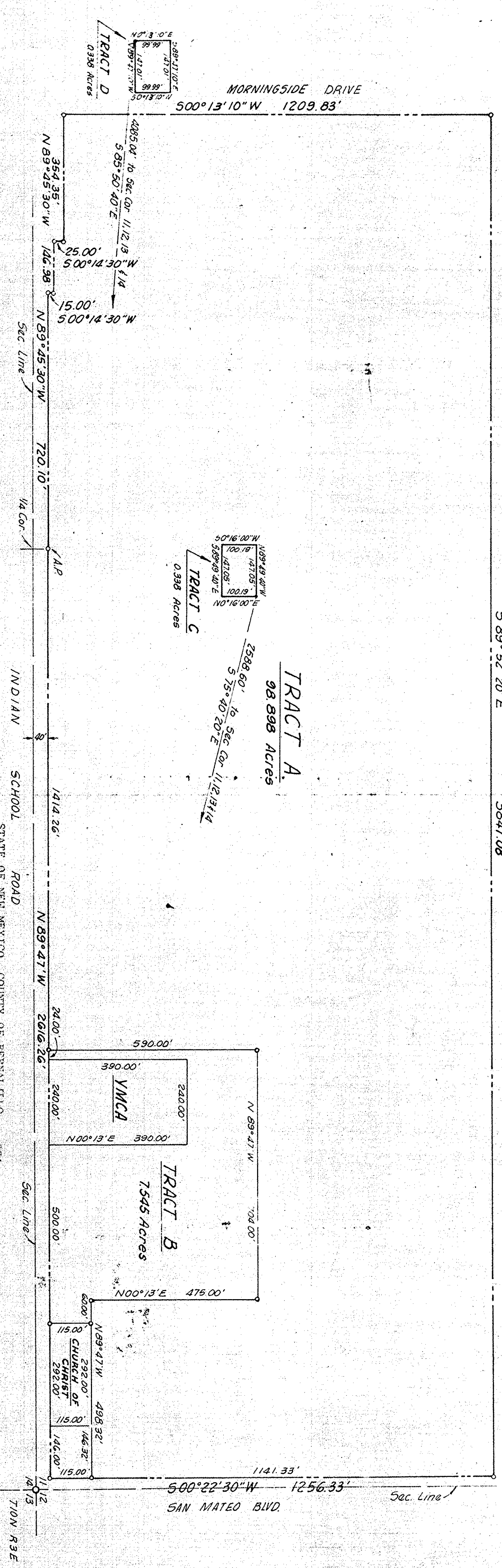
# BLOCKS 1-11 & BLOCKS 20-30 NETHERWOOD PARK SECOND FILING

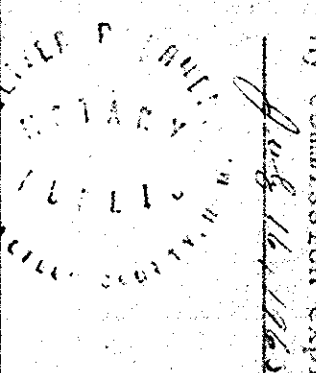
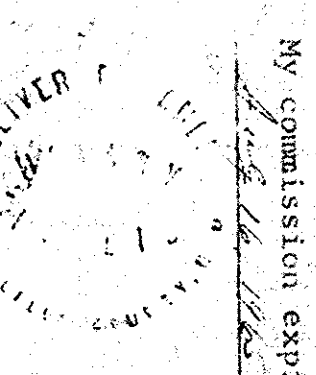
